TRANSITION TIPS FROM MLB PANELISTS



Adapt and overcome, build a list of what you have done in the military and the idea is to create a certain mindset. A mentor outside the military space can give you the perspective you would need to smoothly transition.





Any MOS that you acquired in the military is transferable to civilian life. You have completed basic training and then learned new skills to master your role in the military. You can break down your skillsets and explore different industries to branch out in.

Take advantage of networking, internships, and apprenticeships. The more connections you make, the more you expose yourself to different divisions within the company.
