

Tips for Your Mentorship: Protégé is Deployed

You can still make a meaningful impact on your Protégé's career development from a distance. Here are some tips to consider if your Protégé is deployed.

- Discuss communication methods and schedules as soon as the mentorship begins
- Discuss the Protégé's proximity to reliable access to the Internet, phones, libraries, etc. Try to develop a flexible plan for communication and adapt to changes as necessary
- Suggest books that both Protégé and Mentor could read and discuss through email.
 These could be books on military service, leadership, business, etc
- Email your Protégé top stories from their preferred sector. This could help keep your deployed Protégé abreast of current events in his/her fields of interest
- Discuss the differences between military structure and corporate structure (e.g. how authority is organized, how to stand out positively in both, climbing the corporate/ military ladder, etc)
- Begin networking while deployed, via sites such as ACP AdvisorNet (<u>acp-advisornet.org</u>), <u>HireHeroesusa.org</u> or <u>LinkedIn.com</u>, by joining industry-specific communities or connecting with professionals in their field
- Help your Protégé identify ideal job postings and develop a long-term plan to become a qualified candidate for such jobs
- Develop 2-, 5- and 10-year plans with your Protégé and help identify where their military service fits into them
