FORMAT

It could be a summer BBQ, a birthday party, an evening cocktail party, a weekend brunch, a Lunch and Learn at your office, or any other type of event that you enjoy. You know what will work best for your friends and colleagues. Choose a place where you and your guests will be most comfortable. This could be at your own home or apartment, or a meet-and-greet at your workplace. Please contact Genevieve King, Manager of Fund Development, so we can work with you directly to plan and implement a fun and successful event.

WHAT TO SERVE

Refreshments can be as simple or as complicated as you like. You could consider seeking help from friends who like to cook or local restaurants who may be sympathetic to our cause. Make the event a potluck, or provide refreshments yourself.

WHO TO INVITE

Friends, family members, colleagues, acquaintances - it's up to you to decide who to invite, get out the invitations (mail and/or email) and keep track of who is coming, so you will know how many to prepare for. Follow-up emails and phone calls will definitely increase attendance.

LOGISTICS

- · Let guests know how to get to the event location, where they can park, and if there is nearby public transit available.
- Ask a friend or two to serve as greeters, if needed. They'll answer the door, take coats, make sure people sign in and help collect checks.
- Let ACP know if there are any further materials or support we can provide for your event.
- At some point during the event, take 10 minutes to welcome guests and explain how you are connected to ACP.
 Briefly walk guests through ACP's key programs and our impact so far. Consider showing our video, which is
 available at acp-usa.org/about-us/program-overview. Encourage your guests to visit the ACP website and ask them
 not to leave without filling out a pledge form. ("Please sign up to support ACP. You can give tonight using these
 donor pledge forms [hold one up] or donate online at ACP-USA.org.")
- Consider setting a fundraising goal for the event and announce it to guests when you ask for their support at the event.
